PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Robak. The question is the adoption of AM2496 to LB 659. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on the Robak amendment to LB 659. Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Mr. President, could I have a call of the house, please, and a roll call vote?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor of the Legislature. Would members please record your presence. The house is under call. Would those members in the Chamber please record your presence. Senator Schimek, Senator Brown, Senator Bruning, Senator Jones, Senator Beutler, the house is under call. The house is under call. Would members, please, that are in the Chamber, please record your presence. A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, when you're ready, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 787-788.) 16 ayes, 19 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is not agreed to. The call is raised.
