PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would members please return to the Chamber and check in. The house is under call. Members in the Legislature, if you'd please record your presence. Senator Bohlke, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Rise to ask for a reverse order.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brashear, Senator Preister, Senator Jensen, Senator Jones, Senator Cudaback. Senator Preister, Senator Cudaback, the house is under call. Senator Lynch, it's my understanding that Senator Cudaback may have left the building. (Laughter)

SENATOR LYNCH: And, Mr. Speaker, I'm sure the State Patrol probably couldn't help find him anyhow, so I'd be willing to proceed with the vote, hopefully a successful one.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Lynch. We have a roll call vote in reverse order. When you're ready, Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 800.) 22 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is not advanced. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Move to adjourn until tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the house be adjourned? Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. We are adjourned.
