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February 25, 2000 LB 715

SENATOR RAIKES: Correct. Correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Now, is that based on...on what...what it would have been this year is this would have been in place, not what...what they received here a few weeks ago. Is that right?

SENATOR RAIKES: That's correct. If you're saying that this tells you if February 1, 2000, that LB 715 would have been the law of the state rather than the current law, that is what the difference would have been.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I think there are...there is some confusion there that these numbers would be over or above what they received on...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...February 1st, but that's not the case. This is what it would have been February 1st if LB 715 would have been in place.

SENATOR RAIKES: Rather than the current law, that's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you. That's all...

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...I have.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Vrtiska. Seeing no further lights, Senator Raikes, you're recognized to close on the amendment to the amendments.
