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hadn't had a chance to pursue this, but those there now will be transferred to Tecumseh when it becomes on-line as new, is that the intent, Senator Thompson?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Do you yield, Senator Thompson?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes. I don't know where they would be transferred to, but the adult system would have more space and I think that is a reasonable request to allow the department then, because they have space either freed up or at Tecumseh, to reconsider.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: All right. I really wanted to say...

SENATOR THOMPSON: So I don't know what they're doing (inaudible).

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...in all our discussion I hadn't been clear. I had...

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...I'd been reluctant to transfer this, but if there's...with the new room apparently there is going to be adequate space to handle younger juveniles in this particular circumstance and that's what I wanted to be assured of. I heard you say that and I just wanted to be assured of that, so.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And I guess my statement would be that there is more space and there may be things that the department needs to manage to adequately serve that population. There were there a year and a half ago, all of them, plus the ones younger than 18.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. And may I ask another question? So there's two points in this amendment, it restores the language on the transportation, when it becomes a county cost...or takes...makes it a state cost that was a county cost, and it does transfer the facility and delays the date for the six months. Is that accurate?

SENATOR THOMPSON: I think so. I'm just going to restate the
