SENATOR WEHRBEIN: All right.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...if we're both saying the same thing. Currently, it is a responsibility of the county. The amendment would have made it the responsibility of the state. The amendment now makes it the responsibility of the county again and the counties have agreed to that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Oh, I did misunderstand.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yeah, I didn't think I heard that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right, okay. So the dollars then...I'm confused of what you talked to me earlier about then.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Earlier...if this amendment passes, also stapled to the back page is the fiscal note and county costs are not going to have to be...transportation costs won't be in there with this amendment, but also, because the secure youth facility is transferred to the juvenile system at midpoint in the year, I'll have to introduce an amendment to the A bill if this passes because that will be less money than would have been required had it been transferred in July.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, I think that should be made clear. Maybe you want to explain that a little bit more, because I...that's all I have.
