They did nothing, so he contacted me. And to make a long story short, he was given the runaround to such an extent that I had to file a complaint with the Chief Justice against the Bar Association. Then, lo and behold, the lawyer over there, and it was not Dennis Carlson, the lawyer who was on his case said, oh, I forgot I left this information, this material in the computer for over a month. When I get involved, all of a sudden people find things that had already been done but they just did not process it. To make a long story short, that lawyer ultimately wound up being disbarred. But, again, why did I have to do it? I'm not paid. I'm not even a lawyer. But if I don't do it, who will? How many people feel comfortable knowing that there are judges who can commit multiple acts of sexual harassment, which doesn't just include inappropriate words but conduct, grabbing, clutching, stroking, fondling, and know that nothing is going to be done about it? How many of you feel comfortable, you go there before a judge sitting up there in those robes and he is a worse offender than the people he is going to sentence to jail, worse than the people he is going to lecture, worse than the people from whom he will not accept any excuse? And if a lawyer told a judge, Judge, "f" you, what do you think the judge would do to the lawyer? The judge could find the lawyer in contempt and have the lawyer put in jail. And the judge would have charges brought against the lawyer, but when the judge does it, who is to set the standard? People look the other way and the Judicial Qualifications Commission says, well, that's okay because the judge did it. Who on this floor, who is a lawyer, will tell me and my colleagues that a lawyer in an official setting during a judicial proceeding could tell a judge "f" you and do it with impunity? You all know that would not be the case. So who am I talking to this morning? Not my colleagues, maybe some are listening, but I'm talking to the people who watch us. I want them to know that there is one person in this state who takes seriously the work that judges are to perform, who is unafraid to take on the judges, the Judicial Qualifications, the lawyers,...
