SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Suttle. Any further discussion on the committee amendments on LB 930? Seeing none, Senator Landis. He waives closing, so the question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 930. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the committee amendments, have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendments are adopted. Discussion on the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 930? Seeing none, Senator Landis waives closing on LB 903. The question is the advancement of the bill to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 930.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill advances. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 944, by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5 of this year, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Wickersham, to open on LB 944.
