SENATOR SCHIMEK: Well, the way the committee statement reads, I guess maybe that was what alerted me or got me wondering about it anyway, because it looks in there, it says that you're replacing the authorization to require a birth certificate prior to entrance into school with authorization to require the information required by Section 43-2007. And, not being familiar with 43-2007, it made me wonder.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Well, we...we took this out because the newer law, which is 43...whatever,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...2007.

SENATOR SUTTLE: ...is newer,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR SUTTLE: ...is newer language.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you very much.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Any further discussion on the Suttle amendment? Seeing none, Senator Suttle, would you like to close? She waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Suttle amendment to the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed...record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Suttle amendment to committee amendments, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Suttle...waives closing on the committee amendments. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1401. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.
