our constituents will have good service, have a reasonable...a reasonable price without the appropriate authority being given to the Public Service Commission. There is no other way. Unless one of the senators can offer one, I certainly have not...have not heard any. Last year, when we dealt with slamming, something our constituents were wanting us to do something about, what did we do? We gave the Public Service Commission fining authority when it comes to slamming. Why did we do that? Because we had no other effective way to implement the law with regard to slamming. We really had no other way to deal with it. Some of the things that were said were accurate. This does touch everyone. This area, everyone has a telephone or hopefully access to a telephone. Telecommunications touches everyone. What is...what is the ability of the Public Service Commission, without this bill, to effectively implement their order? I'll tell you what it is. It is to revoke the certificate to do business in the state of Nebraska. Now, if you and I would believe...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...that, with the hundreds and thousands of customers of a particular company who would be affected by revoking a certificate to do business, that that is something that's going to happen, I suggest to you that...that it isn't; that there has to be something in between having no power and having the ability to revoke the certificate to do business. And if we can fine a cab company up to \$5,000 a day, for heaven sakes, with the mitigating language having the ability to go to \$10,000 in this kind of situation is not unreasonable. This is a quasi-judicial body. If someone feels they are wrong, they have the right to appeal. They go directly into the Court of Appeals.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR BROMM: They bypass the district court. Thank you.
