SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is Father Richard Quinn from the Holy Name Catholic Church in Omaha, which is Senator Bourne's district. Father.

FATHER QUINN: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I call the thirty-seventh day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: The report of registered lobbyists for this week to be inserted in the Legislative Journal. Senator Chambers offers a motion with respect to LB 510, that'd be to reconsider the vote on the veto. That will be laid over, Mr. President. That's all that I have this morning. (Legislative Journal pages 877-878.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Before we move on to debate bills this morning, your printed agenda has two changes into it. Obviously we dealt with LB 921 so that will not be on the agenda this morning, and on the consent calendar list you should strike off LB 1241. That's the first bill on the back of your agenda. LB 1241 will not be taken up. Mr. Clerk, we next move to General File 2000 committee priority bills, LB 973.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 973, introduced by the General Affairs Committee and signed by its membership. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5 of this year, referred to General Affairs, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Mr. President.
