SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...something jumps across those spaces on occasion. Well, it's not making the leap in my brain and I'm missing something, so I will listen to the discussion.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I do have a question for Senator Janssen, if he would be...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR REDFIELD: ...willing to answer. Senator Janssen, we know that it is possible to purchase liquor over the Internet. We also know that the federal government has established a moratorium on establishing any new taxes on Internet sales and I'm questioning you as to how that would be dealt with in this issue. Would Internet sales then be exempt from this taxation?

SENATOR JANSSEN: No.

SENATOR REDFIELD: So we could be in violation of the federal moratorium?

SENATOR JANSSEN: No. No, we're not talking about Internet right now. We're talking about...

SENATOR REDFIELD: Oh, so, no, they would not be taxed over the Internet?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Oh, we...we...no, we're not taxing Internet right now...

SENATOR REDFIELD: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...because of that federal moratorium.
