SENATOR JANSSEN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...though.

SENATOR JANSSEN: No, we're not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you feel that the law that relates to them would automatically attach to a private individual.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, as far as being responsible for paying...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...that tax.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if the private individual is neither a wholesaler nor a retailer, it doesn't seem to me that those specific laws could apply to the individual.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, they do on sales tax because you have to...the sales tax is an obligation on all purchases that has to be paid.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Or a use tax because you might...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Or use tax.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...buy it someplace else...

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...where they don't have a sales tax.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, no, but there...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But people don't pay...

SENATOR JANSSEN: I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...people don't pay the use tax.
