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homes?

SENATOR AGUILAR: Not that I'm aware of, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They wouldn't give somebody a lift to the doctor, if that is needed? Or you are just not sure?

SENATOR AGUILAR: I don't have a full list of all their duties now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, of the list, of what you have on the list, what do they do?

SENATOR AGUILAR: Like I said, their main function is to provide meals and to provide, you know, a place for seniors to get together.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So if the people don't have a way to get there, then they are just out in the cold, those seniors who might need a meal but they can't get there.

SENATOR AGUILAR: Not all seniors can.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And this program would not provide them transportation?

SENATOR AGUILAR: This program would expand the amount of seniors that could get to their programs.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, I meant the Grand Generation that you're talking about, that program out there does not provide transportation for these seniors who...to these old people because that's what I'm talking about?

SENATOR AGUILAR: They may on a limited basis, I'm not just sure of all their responsibilities.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, and I'll continue the discussion but this amendment...
