the county court judges will not have quite an equal say with the district court judges. Under the new rule as proposed in this amendment it would be...that clerk would be appointed by the district judges with the concurrence of the county judges. But it would be the district judges that would be proposing the person to fill that position. That is a compromise that I think is...is good from the point of view of the district judges. It makes the county judges a little less happy than they were under the previous amendment, but I think they can live with it. So I would offer that to you as hopefully the last and final compromise necessary on this bill. Thank you.

**SENATOR BROMM:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I wonder if Senator Beutler would yield to a question?

**SENATOR BROMM:** And that...where's that at on the...I've got AM2008. Is that...

**SENATOR BEUTLER:** That would be on page 19, at the top of the page, Senator.

**SENATOR BROMM:** Okay.

**SENATOR BEUTLER:** And that...that's the...well, that's the existing committee amendment language, obviously.
