SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...as the state took over the system.

SENATOR BROMM: So...so would that be under the jurisdiction of the State Court Administrator's Office?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, yes.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. So year one and year two, any reduction in staff would be the clerk of the district court's prerogative or judgment, and third year State Court Administrator, and thereafter, after that, State Court Administrator's Office.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay, okay, thank you. My time is about up, so I'll put my light on again if I have more questions. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: At this point in time I'm going to move to our motion to suspend the rules for a hearing notice. Today is a day of full debate, we'll begin this week, so we will continue with this bill, but it will be after our Select File things that start at 1:30. Again, to remind the body at 1:30 we're going to go to clean E & R amendments, or clean E & R...I'll eventually get the process right, we're going to go to clean Select File, excuse me, at 1:30. After that we'll return to this bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 13, to permit cancellation of a public hearing scheduled on LR 304 by the Natural Resources Committee.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on your motion to suspend the rules.
