ASSISTANT CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. We are now open for discussion on the committee amendments. Senator Vrtiska, did you wish to speak on the committee amendments?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: (Microphone malfunction) Mr. President, members of the body, I'd simply urge the adoption of committee amendments as explained. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no lights, the question before the body is, shall the committee amendments be adopted to LB 414? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments as amended, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments to LB 414 are adopted. We are now open for discussion on the bill itself, on LB 414. Senator Vrtiska, on the bill.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I'd like to ask Senator Beutler a couple questions, if I might.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Sure.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Beutler, in looking over the sheet that you sent out, I noticed that some counties gain and some counties lose. Actually that's not my main concern. I'm trying to figure out how this will affect those counties that have...already have a clerk that serves as a clerk of the district court and how they would fit into this picture. I was trying to review the bill here, but I thought you could explain it to me easier, if you could quickly, and I have a couple other questions.
