SENATOR ROBAK: If you'll refer to your pink sheet page...

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, right.

SENATOR ROBAK: ...in the handout...

SENATOR KREMER: Yes.

SENATOR ROBAK: ...it starts November 15, 2001, the Department of Agriculture and the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature will report on the statutory changes required and the anticipated scope of the program; June 1, 2002, implement the pilot program for state meat inspection. That will give the Department of Agriculture time to do the things we've been speaking about. And 2004, terminate the program if there are less than five programs participating. And 2006, sunset the pilot program if it need be "sunsetting".
