Support. It adds the President of the Nebraska Electronic Transfer System or his or her designee on the task force. It reduces the number of representatives appointed to the task force, from the retail grocery industry, from three to two; and it reduces the number of recipients of public assistance or advocates of such persons appointed to the task force, from four to three. The amendment also requires reimbursement for task force member expenses and provides the actions of the task force require a majority vote of the members present at the meetings where there is a quorum. The task force does terminate on January 1, 2004. The amendment also makes various technical changes to the bill. I would urge the body to adopt the committee amendments and advance this bill. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. (Visitor introduced.) Debate on the committee amendments? Senator Price.

SENATOR PRICE: I would like to speak on the bill, please.
