SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bourne, may I ask you a question?

SENATOR BOURNE: You sure can.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You were speaking of HIPAA. Have you ever heard of a person named "Hippa"?

SENATOR BOURNE: I have.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, did "Hippa"...well, did you know that "Hippa" put a mouse in a box?
