SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Jones, followed by Senators Bourne, Tyson, Baker, Janssen, and Beutler. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, I want to stand in support of these committee amendments. I realize they're drew a lot narrower than the bill is and so it...the bill was a lot broader and would include the radio stations and everything. But I think this is the right way to go and what I mean by narrow, this gives you just a small window to get this done. And I realize that the federal mandate is coming down and they're going to be done by, supposedly, December of 2003 and so that gives it that much time and also three years to file for a refund and that, like we've heard on the floor already, that that's unusual to have it done that way. But the federal government sent this mandate down and I figure on the state level what we can do to help out a little bit would be to give them the refund on the sales tax that they have to pay for all equipment they need to put in. And also, this makes them earmark exactly what they had to do to make this improvement, so that's...that's another reason that I think that it's drew about as narrow as we could get it and still comply and be able to help them out a little bit from the state level to do this. So this is a...this is a bill that I took as my personal priority bill this year so that hopefully we can get some help to them before it gets too far along before they can have to get this all done. So, with that, I would just support the committee amendments and then continue to support the bill. Thank you.
