SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Discussion on this appointment? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, my no vote on this appointment is carrying out the protest that I have. Our ratio of appointees this morning is much better than it was the other day, 50 percent to 50 percent, so I want to thank Senator Vrtiska for at least giving me an opportunity to vote once this morning. But my no vote has nothing to do with this individual's qualification or suitability for this appointment. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Vrtiska, would you like to close? He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the second part of the Business and Labor confirmation report. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 965-966.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CROSBY: The report is adopted. Mr. Clerk, General File.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 171, introduced by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January, last year, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File, discussed yesterday.
