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eyes and he got to thinking about this and the flag furlled in front of his eyes, well, in the back of his eyes, and he heard the "Star Spangled Banner". He said, uh-uh, we can't do this. He said, even businessmen who lie, cheat and steal pay taxes. So Jonathan Winters was off. He made a mistake. There are businesspersons who don't want to pay taxes, even if they might do the other things that he said. A policy decision will be made today if this bill is enacted, and if you're going to favor one small part of the money-making industry, and by that I don't mean the U.S. Mint, others are justified in coming to the Legislature and saying, hey, give me a break. One gentleman has been coming to us year after year after year saying, I overpaid on some sales tax; I didn't even owe it; give it back to me. But the statute of limitations has run and, because of the policy that requires a statutory limit on the time during which a person can reclaim these things, he was cut off. Well, here is an entity which is asking to just refund all the taxes that they pay. Why? Because we want to stay in this business and make a lot of money and if you don't give us...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...our tax money back we won't make as much, we won't have as much to show in profit; so let us not pay taxes. Well, I know the little grocer next door or across the street has to pay taxes, but don't make me pay taxes. I recognize that that self-employed woman who's taken in sewing and ironing and washing and working her little fingers to the bone, I know she is going to have to pay some taxes when she purchases various products that she needs in her little business, but let her pay the taxes because I don't want to pay them. Then he runs out and jumps in his Ferrari and shooting gravel up on the poor widder woman, against the window of the little grocer, scoots on out to the country club and has three or four holes of golf and says, I just pulled a fast one there, I ain't paying no more taxes so I'm going to buy me a new set of golf clubs and a motorized golf cart, because I don't pay any taxes.
