SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I appreciate that. I will visit with Senator Connealy about that also.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and that's all I'll say at this point because it is 11:15. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers and Senator Wehrbein. Mr. Clerk, do you have items or...

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. We will move to Final Reading. I would ask the senators to take their seats for Final Reading and check in, please. Would the senators please take your seats and check in for Final Reading. Baker, Bohlke and Senator Bourne. Senator Bromm, Senator Bruning, Brashear. Senator Coordsen, Senator Dickey, we're under Final Reading, please report your presence. Senator Landis, Senator Preister, Senator Robak. Senator Brashear, would you like to record your presence. Senator Coordsen, Senator Landis, Senator Robak. Senator Stuhr, I will recognize you to introduce your motion on suspending the rules.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Madam President and members of the Legislature. I move to spend the rules, Rule 4, Section 2, and Rule 6, Section 7(b) to permit consideration of LR 20CA on Final Reading, and just a comment. This is the last day to send LR 20CA to the Secretary of State so this amendment can appear on the primary election ballot, and I ask for your support in suspending the rules to allow Final Reading on this amendment.
