SENATOR BROMM: I would hope we'd all do that.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Chambers, on the Kremer amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm sorry I missed the exchange that went on just before that, but I was listening very closely to my colleague, Senator Kremer. And Senator Kremer brought something to my attention which I was not aware of prior to his discussing it with me. So, what I thought was an iceberg, Senator Bromm, turns out to have been an optical illusion. And since it's an optical illusion, it has no real substance. So just strike all of that discussion that I had with you previous to that. But I will say this, since I'm on the floor, there is a provision in the bill itself, as it stands, which is troubling to me, and I'll mention it before I draft an amendment, so you can be thinking about it. Senator Kristensen had discussed this when we were at the prior stage of debate. But it has to do with this franchise being in a situation where the manufacturer could take possession of it for a given period of time. Oh, that would be on page 12 of the E & R amendments. In lines 22 and 23 are the words "at a reasonable price and on reasonable terms and conditions". Then if you go across the street to page 13, in lines 8 and 9 are these words, "within a reasonable time and under reasonable terms and conditions". I see that as the state attempting to write the terms of a contract to further protect this particular group that is to be given this benefit by the state exemption from competition. Those are words that I'm going to try to amend out of the bill, because I don't believe the state ought to make those kind of determinations. There is no definition of reasonable, so I don't know who is to make that determination. And since I've got my light on here, and Senator Kremer's amendment with his part and yours is no longer that much of an issue for me, I want to use the opportunity to raise this point and let you look at it. I had talked about this at the earlier stage of debate. But we had amended out some provisions of the bill, and you had promised, and you delivered on it, to get this
