through a dealer. Doesn't have to be by that dealer, but it definitely would need to be through the dealer in terms of the dealer being involved in the process, arranging for it, putting the dealers bonding and licensing credibility behind the deal, so to speak, and so it could be done through the dealer, but the word "by", I think, is a more restrictive word and means that they actually physically have to deliver that car. It needs to be done through the dealer, that was the intent. And so we're simply proposing to change the word "by" to "through" with that rationale.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay, Senator Bromm. We are open for discussion on AM2548 to LB 1018. Senator Bromm, seeing no lights, did you wish to close on your amendment? Senator Bromm passes. The question before the body is, shall AM2548 be adopted to LB 1018? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: AM2548 is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Bromm and I have had a discussion or two, so I want to look at the way that amendment is drafted in the context of the existing material, because maybe what I will do is strike all of subsection (b) or subdivision (b) of subsection 3. So let me ask Senator Bromm a question, if he will yield.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bromm, the reason I didn't strike it all is because I didn't know whether or not there is language elsewhere in this subsection or subdivision that would indicate that the franchise is for sale by the...
