because they know the quality of my work, but if I perform it, it's not guaranteed under this warranty, because I'm not authorized to do those kind of repairs. And I'm saying this, hoping that people will have enough time to look at...oh, well maybe nobody is concerned about it. So I will just state what the amendment does. It would insure that a franchisee has been assigned this territory and is providing the service before this prohibitory language comes into effect. If nobody is performing the service, there is no reason to prohibit another franchisor, franchisee or other person being authorized to do such work. But if you still have questions, I will answer them.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. We are discussing the Chambers amendment to LB 1018. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. The words that Senator Chambers is proposing to insert, "and being served by", I don't really have any problem with, because if that area isn't being served, if there is an assignment but it's not being fulfilled by the franchisee, I see no reason why a separate care facility shouldn't be allowed. So I don't have any problem with the amendment. I would...there's something I'm trying to track down right now, Senator Chambers, and I don't have the answer as I'm at the microphone. But I think if someone is not providing the service for the warranty work, there's a short period of time after which they can have their license pulled by the franchise...by the dealer's board. And I think it's a fairly short period of time. And if I get that answer before we're done with the bill, I will tell you. But that's another safeguard from that standpoint. But I have no objection to the amendment, encourage the body to adopt the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Chambers, there are no further lights on. Did you wish to close on your amendment, FA316? The question before the body is the Chambers amendment, FA316, to LB 1018. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.
