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basis I believe the buck should stop with me, not with them. If I pay them, I think that's a completely different deal. I think if I hire a CPA to take care of my...my accounts then I think some responsibility should go with it because that is his business, but when they volunteer and if you accept them as volunteers, then you are accepting that responsibility. So that's the way I feel about this subject.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Engel. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I know my campaign treasurer is going to be real ticked off when she finds out others get paid and she doesn't, but, oh well. Fayette, don't leave me. I rise in support of the amendment and the motion to return to Select File. Senator Redfield has worked very hard on this amendment. There have been several stages of drafts and she has visited with Accountability. But a question did just occur to me, Senator Redfield, as I looked this over, and I don't know that it's a real significant question but it's one we should perhaps think about. If a candidate is personally responsible for the debts of a campaign and can use the campaign funds to help pay off...I don't mean debt, a filing...filing fees and those kinds of things, and they can use their campaign funds to help pay off, what if the candidate would suddenly keel over with a heart attack and is no longer there, is no longer present and living, cannot be personally responsible, I would assume, anymore for those debts. Does that...mean, does it fall to the treasurer to see that those things are done or is there no longer any responsibility for those kinds of fines and fees? I just...I'm not even...I'm not even sure I want an answer. I just...I just thought of that kind of at the last minute, and that would be a very isolated situation. I don't have any problem with adopting this amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Crosby, members of the Legislature. Senator Redfield, to elaborate a little bit more on that, could you tell what, in the case where the candidate or the officeholder does expire, what...who would...who would be responsible then for disposing of those...of those campaign
