SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 921. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on that bill, Senator.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 921 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 921 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. The bill advances. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Smith, LB 957. The first amendment is...are E & Rs, Senator. (AM7205, Legislative Journal page 782.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Mr. Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 957.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt E & R amendments to LB 957. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment, AM2639 by Senator Landis. I understand Senator Preister is going to handle that for him.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Preister, to open on the amendment.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. On this particular amendment Senator Landis has asked if it could be withdrawn, and then we have an amendment that will be...has already been filed that we'll take up later. So could the Clerk please withdraw this amendment?

SENATOR CROSBY: It is withdrawn.
