SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: It is technical in two respects. It is substantive in one other that Senator Raikes was speaking to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Could you tell me the substantive part because that's what I think I missed.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The substantive change is the reduction in the gap, if you will, between the minimum levy effort that's required in order to receive state aid and the local effort rate that's calculated in the bill. We're reducing that from five cents to two cents, which, as Senator Raikes indicated and I hope I indicated but maybe not as clearly in my remarks, is it means that you will have to spend local dollars first before you'd get any aid from the state.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, that's what I understood him to say, but I wanted...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: And that's...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to be sure he wasn't just making a comment...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...rather than discussing the amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: After this amendment of yours is adopted then I would have a few comments and maybe some questions on the bill,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...but I wanted to be sure what is going to be in it. Thank you.
