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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...right, it was \$100 million was spread over three years and this was the first year of that.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So then next year there was...there would have been nothing went to community colleges...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...under the plan last year.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So it was a one-year...one-year situation. Now we're coming back and we're saying we had...you had appropriated \$30 million, or the Governor did or someone,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Per the Governor's bill, yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...all right, that would...was again going to go to the community colleges. We did not intend that last year. We were working with that \$100 million. The second year was to go for direct property tax relief. This year we come back and say, all right, we do have \$30 million here, we're going to give that to the community colleges. But then we also had \$10 million that we needed for something else so we say we're going to lower that to \$20 million. The intent last year was not to have this \$30 million ongoing. It was a one-year deal. So actually we...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's...that's the way I'd understand it, yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. So now this year we're going to say next year there won't be \$30 million but there will be \$20 million. Is that right?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Or not \$35 million but \$25 million.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's right.
