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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is that the same \$147,000, is coming from the Military Department over to the State Patrol?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so there's only one amount involved here. And what does that amount cover, if you know?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It covers the overtime at Whiteclay a year ago for the situation out there, and it's absorbed now out of the Governor's Emergency Fund instead of being a direct appropriation.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. I was up there and I did see what they were doing, but I didn't know they had snipers hidden to shoot people, I didn't know that. But I did see the Colonel dressed in his black fatigues tucked in his boots looking like a storm trooper when they had blocked off the public highway so that cars couldn't go, and I said, you mean to tell me that the State Patrol is going to stop traffic on the public highway and you're going to stop me? Well, not you, Senator. Well, why not me? Am I better than any other person in this state? I won't give (laugh) the answer. But I mean what kind of nonsense was that? They have all of these guys just running around, playing at being storm troopers, and there was no need for all of them to be there but they like to go through those shows. Sometimes the Colonel has come to the Judiciary Committee hearing with a big old pistol on his side that he can hardly sit in the seat with because it catches on the arm of the chair, and one time I had to ask him, why do you come armed to the Judiciary Committee like that; do you feel that something bad is going to happen to you? With all these bullets, the gun, handcuffs and what...whatever other military type paraphernalia he had he said, well, no, he wasn't afraid to come before the committee, and that kind of reassured me. But some of these amounts are not going to be analyzed at all. They will be accepted, totalled into the amount that is going to be paid for by taxpayers and allowed to slide across the board. I'd just mention that as one because I wasn't sure whether there were two amounts involved there. I would like to ask Senator
