But I did want to respond to the major issues that drove the \$60 mill...the \$60 million of Health and Human Services deficit requests that we're looking at. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Chambers, there are no lights on, you'd like to withdraw the amendment at this time?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, yes.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is no...without objection, the amendment is withdrawn. For debate on the committee amendments to LB 1214, Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. I believe I won't have anything else to add. We've had a very thorough discussion, and remind the committee or the body that this is the committee amendment that makes basically the change in the money. The original bill, as amended by that, is necessary for the transfer of funds for that Property Tax Relief Fund. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1214. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The committee amendments are agreed to. Debate on the advancement of LB 1214? Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker, I don't believe I have anything else to add to what I said, so thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 1214 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.
