I'm sure you have your light on, Senator Brown, and perhaps you can enlighten me on those points. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Janssen, approximately two minutes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you. Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Bohlke, for the time. I remember those discussions last year very well. We thought we had a workable system. Well, we had a system that was working, as Senator Bohlke alluded to. Our clerks were taking care of this in each...in our respective counties, taking care of it very well. But then "Big Father", in Washington, said, you can't do that anymore, you're going to have to have a centralized system. Well, the centralized system, as far as I was concerned, was still in place, and we could have taken care of it very well at a lot less cost. And I think, if we would have been penalized at that time for not using a certain type of computer system, would have been far less than what we ended up having happen to us this year, the way it was. And I'm concerned about electronic benefits transfers also. If we go down that same path with it and don't get some input from the people who first hand know what's happening on the local level, we're going to be in trouble again. We're going to have to keep people involved in that system,...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...or we're going to have the very same thing happen with that. Hopefully the administration will work with us and realize what we're trying to establish with the EBT system so that kind of thing doesn't happen again. We're going to face a deadline on that also, because in the year 2002 we are not going to have the paper food stamps to work with. We have to have a system in place then. For heavens sakes, let us go down the right path with that, so we don't end up in this same situation. If it would have been...I...I...in working with this last year, I thought we had a solution that was going to be acceptable. We had a system which worked. I remember Senator Chambers talked about it. When we went to the clerks with the problems, those people who were getting the support payments, it was working. "Big Brother" comes in and says, you have to do it a different way,...
