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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: In this amendment, it is \$2 million; \$1 million each year for the next two years for the grant program, and it's \$850,000 per year for two years to the Microenterprise Fund that's already in existence.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And now for the clarification, that \$10 million that was freed up yesterday for use on A bills would cover that same two-year period that this bill is talking about or maybe next year there would be some additional money available to fund A bills? And let me ask it a different way, that \$10 million deals only with this year, is that true?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: This coming year, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so this bill would take only \$1 million for this year?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, starting July 1st, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So there's...I mean if I could use the point of education here maybe,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Sure.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...the second year appropriations that are in all A bills is actually...does have to be reaffirmed in the second year when we start the first year of the next biennium.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So any A bills that we have for the first year is, in fact it's appropriated in this next fiscal year. The year after that would have to be reaffirmed in the appropriations process.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But the point I want to make clear is that the \$10 million will deal only with A bills for this year. That 10 million does not have to carry over to fund anything in the second year of any of these A bills.
