SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I would like to ask Senator Thompson a couple of questions, if I could.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Thompson, would you yield?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator, I'm looking at a page here out of a master plan recommendation by Chinn Planning, Inc., which has got three phases and has got phase one, which includes Geneva, YRTC facility at Kearney, and other sites. Are you familiar with what I'm looking at?

SENATOR THOMPSON: I think you have a slide presentation. What I have is the final plan, but we can probably...

SENATOR RAIKES: They...they should be comparable though.

SENATOR THOMPSON: They should be comparable.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. I notice on this plan now there's a phase one that totals \$19 million, well, almost \$20 million.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: And that has years 2000 to 2003 associated with it. And there are three subheadings within that. One of them is Geneva and the subtotal there is \$6,185,000.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yep.

SENATOR RAIKES: Kearney is...the subtotal is \$11,682,000, and the other sites the subtotal is \$2,128,000. Are you following those?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. My question is, now, apparently we have selected out of that list of \$20 million worth of items, Number 1-A, which is a new multipurpose building at Geneva. Is that correct?
