SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: And the cost there is \$2,710,500. Is that match with the appropriations we're talking about?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, that was a preliminary report, I believe, and the final report is is 2,946...\$2,946,200, and then when we put together the facility plan bill, because of...an inflation factor was put in the bill, or construction cost factor, so this particular bill is \$3.1 million to adjust for that.

SENATOR RAIKES: So the \$2.7 million has gone up to \$3.1 million, but it's still the same building?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. Now in this listing, that happens to be the first item on the list, but it...it's not the only one. Does the fact that it's first mean that that's top priority? If you only have \$2 million, this is where you should spend it first?

SENATOR THOMPSON: In the meetings that I had with the consultant and when we put together the bill that is still in committee, we took this plan and matched it up so that it would have a fairly steady level of funding over a period of years. That did not come out of committee. I think what will have to happen is we'll come back next year. This amount matched up and from discussions that I had with people in the field, and I have to say that the department is not supportive or opposing this particular plan, it's my understanding that this should be the top priority.

SENATOR RAIKES: When you say "the department" do you mean the Department of Health and Human Services?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: And they're not supportive of this particular plan. Do you mean the Chinn plan or do you mean this specific
