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way I can do that is offer amendments to other parts of the bill. I'm very serious about this. There have not been many bills, in fact there's only one bill that I really fought this session and that was the landlord bill, because it was so bad and it was not prioritized, and there were a lot of things that went into that, so I have not done this on every bill, but this one I will. And if we get to the mainline budget bill then I'm...I have a memory at least that...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...long. Members of the Legislature, why could this not come as a bill? When they were going to build a prison that came as a bill. In fact, the Lieutenant Governor had a bill which ultimately I think was the vehicle which resulted in the prison program being carried into law. When we talked about a facility in Omaha, that was a bill. When they talked about the thing at "Broken Bone", although there wasn't a location at that time, that was a bill. And now they bring us this one and it's not a bill and on one afternoon we're going to be asked to accept it and if I didn't stop it this long then we wouldn't have even been talking about it for this period of time. And I'm conceding at the outstart maybe I can't stop this bill, but I'm going to take as much time and put forth as much effort as necessary to give it a good try.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, you're rec...Senator Chambers, on your motion to bracket.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I will not be waited out on this bill. I have other amendments up there and all I have to do with the bracket motion is, before there is a vote taken on it, just withdraw it, and I can withdraw any motion that has not taken a vote on and I don't have...they always say, is there any objection? Well, motions, you don't have to get the approval of the Legislature to withdraw a motion. The offerer of it just withdraws it. This is not an amendment so I can withdraw it, then I can offer it again, or I could take it to a vote and then move to reconsider it. So if you-all think you can sit me out this short time for this afternoon from four o'clock till midnight,
