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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, even though they talked about General Fund passing and through and like that. Okay, now the other question. That would be, for this program, in addition to what this bill would put into the...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...program. So, there would be a total of how much going into it?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, right up front would be that \$2 million, plus...I've got it all here.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Roughly.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, \$3.7 million, there is \$1 million coming out of General Fund starting...in this bill, coming, and then plus the cigarette tax. So it's \$3.7 million in '01, which is next year, and '02 it goes to \$2.5 million, which includes the cigarette tax and \$1 million from General Fund and so on down the line.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, but none of that is coming from that \$10 million that was freed up for A bills, for senators' A bills?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No, because...no, that's true,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, that's all...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...because we have it in the budget all...we have it in our budget not...not...not the A bill allocation.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And since I understand...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's already in our budget.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...everything you've said so far, (laugh) I don't have anything else to ask you on this. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Vrtiska, on the committee amendments to LB 1349.
