SENATOR BRUNING: Senator, do you think it would be possible if we were to do something to change the law, and obviously this doesn't affect this particular bill, but just in the future change the law so that a claim under \$5,000 approved by the State Claims Board would be automatically approved by the Legislature unless we chose to act in a different way?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator, you're an attorney and I'm not, and I'd suggest that that was something that if you wanted to look into, you certainly have my...you have my approval.

SENATOR BRUNING: Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bruning. (Visitors introduced.) We're now discussing the amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Vrtiska, there are no lights on, did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR VRTISKA: I waive closing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Vrtiska waives on his amendment to the committee amendments. The question before the body is, shall the Vrtiska amendment to the committee amendments to LB 1448 be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Vrtiska's amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Vrtiska amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. We are now on the committee amendments to LB 1448. Senator Beutler on the committee amendments. Senator Beutler waives off. There are no further lights. Senator Vrtiska, as Chairperson of Business and Labor, do you wish to close? He waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendments to LB 1448 be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.
