SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I think Senator Bohlke just left the room. I'd move that we recess till one-thirty.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new A Bill. (Read LB 1092A by title for the first time.) And LB 1348 is reported to Select File. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1086-1091.)
