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Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Not to you, has it?

SENATOR BOHLKE: In my...the time since I've been on...in the Legislature?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, this session.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Oh. No, not this session.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In fact, I haven't even seen any veto...oh, you're a Democrat though, aren't you?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, I am.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you? Is that what you are? Okay. The only ones who were vetoed or threatened with vetoes are Democrats and me, so you still may have that to face but you're...

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, I may.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...you're comfortable with having Senator Thompson's amendment on your bill.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now suppose I told you I was going to do everything I could to kill the bill, everything? Would you feel...

SENATOR BOHLKE: That makes me a little uncomfortable.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not going to do that though (laughter), but I just wanted to show who was feared the most--the Governor or moi? (Laughter) But, in all seriousness, I don't think that \$5,000 is too small an amount, seriously. You're starting on a brand new course. I'd like to ask Senator Thompson a serious question, and it's this. Does this program have any termination point?
