SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes, I'll yield, and the answer is no. What, termination? Oh, it has a cap, but it doesn't sunset. Let me make sure I'm understanding. Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, and I was asking...my question was intended to ask Senator Thompson if there's a sunset but there isn't. So this program could go on and on. And, knowing how people seek teachers' support when they run for reelection, you're going to refund it again because if you put this money into it at this point, you know once it's started that you're not going to do anything except put more and more money into it. So put \$5,000 in it per year to start and then let them, if it's worked out for awhile and you see that these people are really getting this certification on whatever basis and you're satisfied that those people who do that are worthier than the worthy, better than the good, then give them some more money and tell the others, you're not worth this, but these are. Give them \$5,000 and I bet there's not one of them who would turn his or her back and say, you have insulted my dignity; keep your little \$5,000. I bet if you put that \$5,000 (laugh) out there and didn't draw your hand back real quick, you might be walking around with a nub and you certainly wouldn't have that \$5,000 check remaining in your hand. So what I'm going to do is ask for a call of the house, a roll call vote and then I'll be through with this portion of the bill, whatever happens.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused person...or all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Beutler, would you please check in. Senator Bruning, would you check in. Senator Quandahl, the house is under call. Senator Dickey, Senator Engel, Senator
