SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Tell me...tell me what the...from beginning to end, what's the whole story on exceeding your levy?

SENATOR BOHLKE: On the levy?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah.

SENATOR BOHLKE: That goes to the Class I's having districts to place the issue before the whole system, but that's when, if they want to recede that levy authority, that that...

SENATOR BEUTLER: If they want to exceed it.

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...that goes back to the Class I board.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If they want to exceed the...

SENATOR BOHLKE: No,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...levy authority?

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...recede, if they wanted to take it back.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR BOHLKE: If they wanted to end it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If they wanted to end it, then it's just the Class I district board. So they can...now I'm getting back to my other question. Does that mean they can continue to exceed the limitation so long as the Class I board wishes to do so?

SENATOR BOHLKE: The election on the levy is limited to five years.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so the board can continue it for five years but at the end of five years they would have to vote again. Is that...is that the way it works?

SENATOR BOHLKE: That's correct, but they would not be able to do that until they had approval...
