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and make sure the state gets plenty of sales tax? Would the liquor industry oppose an increase in the sales tax on liquor in Nebraska?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I would imagine they would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then they don't want the state to get too much sales tax, do they?

SENATOR JANSSEN: No, the liquor industry, to my knowledge, is not really pushing this bill. I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who is?

SENATOR JANSSEN: I feel that we are not taxing everything that's coming into this state. All right, so why should we be able to ship a case of wine in here and not pay the sales tax on it...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...when you go to the liquor store and buy it and you have to pay the sales tax?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Janssen, when I look at the committee statement, the only...who were the only ones who testified in favor of this bill? Representatives of the liquor industry, isn't that true?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, and there was also someone from the Mothers Against Drunk Drivers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Well, okay. So they want...they want these...they're concerned about the competition? They're not going to go into selling it, are they?

SENATOR JANSSEN: No, they're...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...they're not concerned about the competition. They're concerned about the availability of liquor
