ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 921 by title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 921 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1113-1114.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 921 passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 900, LB 900A, LB 994, LB 1125, LR 291CA, LB 1190, LB 155, and LB 438. Next move to LB 1018.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The first motion, Mr. President, to dispense with the reading at-large.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The question before the body is to dispense with the Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 37 ayes, 3 nays to dispense with Final Reading, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The at-large reading is dispensed with. LB 1018.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1018 by title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1018 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1114-1115.) 43 ayes, 2 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1018 passes. LB 1192E.
