CLERK: 39 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 1317 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President. I am sorry. (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1119.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 1135.

CLERK: Mr. President, pursuant to the Speaker's direction, LB 1135, Senator Brown would move to return the bill for specific amendment, AM2907. (Legislative Journal pages 1119-1121.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brown, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, members, on Select File, we attached an amendment that had to do with the language around some of the Early Childhood Coordinating Committees and there was a concern raised about one line that said that we would comply with federal law. This amendment is very simple. It just adds the words "applicable...all applicable provisions of federal law". And this is to satisfy some of the concerns that Senator Byars raised. Senator Schimek had agreed to pull it back, if we needed to. It's a very simple change and I would ask you to support that change so that we can move this bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. Members, as we look forward to the agenda, the following bills on Select File that have no amendments, other than E & R amendments, are as follows: LB 1436, LB 1436A, LB 213, LB 1352, LB 929, and
