SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our pastor this morning is Steve Ratzlaff from the First Mennonite Church, Lincoln, Nebraska. That's Senator Raikes' district. Please join us. Please rise. Thank you.
