because of the economic situation we're in now, and the requirements that are being placed upon production agriculture to report exact figures of acreages and production. So, with the exception of...of some areas that I don't know that I understand, perhaps hay production, otherwise this really won't change things dramatically, but it will provide, I think, the basis for reasonable valuations, reasonable being in comparison to the production ability across the state in those counties that elect to avail themselves of a special land use valuation plan. With that, Mr. Speaker...Mr. President, I would move for the advancement of or the attachment of the committee amendment to the bill. It becomes the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1124. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.
