PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...interested in discussing whether we could...whether we could change the criteria only for telework, and maybe this should also apply to a larger array of counties, but it's easy for me to focus on that realm of counties because of the need for jobs, the need for economic activity, and the fact that I know that that kind of investment just simply won't come in a lot of cases. So that...that is the reason for my...for my discussion on the bill. As I said, I support the concepts of the bill, I don't want to...to in any way detract from the bill, but I think this is an opportunity to make the bill better, and when you have a chance to comment I would...I would appreciate your comments on it. I am looking at the bill. I'm trying to figure out...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR BROMM: ...what specifically we could do and I'll certainly want to discuss that with you. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Matzke, your light is the only light on. Would you like to use this as your closing?

SENATOR MATZKE: Well, thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. I want to respond to what Senator Bromm was just addressing and...and what he is talking about is a matter of concern to us also and it's a matter that we dealt with and actually discussed with members of the Revenue Committee as to whether the \$100,000 investment is too high a threshold, and that matter was considered very carefully. One of the purposes, one of the consequences of this type of development, would be to increase the tax bases in these communities and, of course, a \$100,000 investment in plant or facilities would increase the tax bases for these communities and increase their...their local tax revenue on that basis.
