PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR ENGEL: ...because, like Senator Brashear said, it is not going to go away.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is not going to be a debate today for the ages. This is political posturing time. No minds are going to be changed. People outside the body have determined how various individuals are going to vote. So I'm not going to waste my time talking about the issue, because that really is not what is before us today, but I will make some comments. This will be a first in that a Chairperson of a committee is joining in a motion to pull a bill from his own committee, and especially so when it's not even his bill. There have always been tensions between the scientific community and the religious community. Scientists have been burned at the stake. Servetas was one, Miguel Servetas was one. We all know about, who's the gentleman who said the earth moves and was stretched on the wheel, and it took the Pope centuries to realize that Galileo deserved an apology? So all of the posturing, all of the appeals to religion, all of the comparisons to Nazi research mean nothing to me, because people are benefitting right now from research done on these very kind of fetal cells. Fetal cells have already provided medications. One priest lauded a certain group of medications, that he said can be used to fight dementia, without realizing that those medications were developed as a result of the very same kind of fetal tissue that he was there to condemn for being used in research here. What I want to do is talk about practical politics. I'm one of the four who voted to keep this thing in committee. I will vote against bringing the thing out here. And, if it gets out here, I'm going to take control of the debate. All you need to do is watch the beginning of the "Outer Limits" and you'll see my purpose.
